Along with others in our church, I have been part of a steering team to help bring a Palau Festival to East Texas. CityFest East Texas is a movement focused on sharing hope to the hurting in our region. The large scale event will take place on Saturday and Sunday (afternoon), October 5 and 6. There will be several other events and trainings that will precede the weekend festival. We are currently enlisting those who will engage with people who have made decisions at the festival, and prayer gatherings have begun.

CityFest East Texas with Andrew Palau is a region-wide evangelistic campaign focused on serving the region and proclaiming the Good News. The vision is to see the Christian community come together in greater unity, service, and proclamation - showing the community at-large the joy, peace, love, and grace of Jesus Christ. At this time – nearly 180 churches in East Texas have committed to be involved.


