Last week I wrote to you from the hospital room where my dad was recovering from hip surgery. Today, I'm writing from the Dominican Republic. Robert and Mindy Watson, Jeff and Connie Pinkerton and I, journeyed on Monday to see about FBC doing mission work here. We are being hosted by Mission of Hope, primarily a Haitian ministry, that, due to political unrest in Haiti, is broadening their efforts to include the DR, and the Haitians living here.

While we are not certain of what the Lord would have us do as a church, it is both encouraging and heart breaking to see what is happening here. The DR, we learned today, has the highest rate of teenage pregnancy in the world. Their education system is woefully lacking, and poverty, of course, is systemic.

BUT GOD.... oh, what a phrase, has raised up Christians within the DR and through partnerships with others around the world, to offer the hope of the Gospel here.

So, as we think about the future of our church, think about the future of our mission to the ends of the earth.

Together We Worship, is not simply about replacing our heating and cooling systems and renovating our Sanctuary. This movement in our church is about proclaiming the Gospel until the Lord comes and building lifelong followers of Jesus to take this Gospel here, there and everywhere to the glory of God!
