### Social Media, Gratitude and a Heart at Peace

I closed my Facebook account almost two months ago. I don't miss it. Facebook sometimes caused me anxiety, anger, even jealousy. Seldom did it cultivate gratitude, or encourage peace.

The Apostle Paul encourages us to rejoice in the Lord, be gentle, and to give thanks while presenting our requests to God... so that the peace of God will guard our hearts and minds in Christ (Philippians 4:4-7). To the church at Colossae, Paul writes, "See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ" (Colossians 2:8). Jesus gives HIS peace, not the "hollow and deceptive philosophy" of peace the world offers.

Does social media cultivate love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control? Do you need to set limits? Are you more thankful after scrolling through friends' updated statuses, comparing your children's successes to others, spending hours video gaming, or shopping? Or are you at greater unrest?

For me, closing the Facebook account has been helpful. What action might be helpful for you? Ask yourself what creates strife in your life? What stimulates gratitude? Gratitude pushes out anxiety and leads to peace; a peace from God in Christ that is wonderfully beyond our understanding and sets up a guard for our hearts and minds.

So, how do you let the peace of Christ rule in your heart? Is the Word of God central in the formation of your ongoing peace? This Advent season, make a decision to focus on that which cultivates the fruit of the Spirit, namely, peace, and free yourself of that which robs you of this gift of God!
